

Florida Teacher Certification Exams (FTCE) Initial Programs

The Florida Teacher Certification Exams (FTCE) and Florida Educational Leadership Examination (FELE) are two state Licensure Examinations for educators seeking K-12 teaching or principal position in Florida public schools. They are administered by Pearson Evaluation Systems. Candidates must take and pass FTCE three exams prior to graduation from an initial teacher certification program to become completers: General Knowledge Exam, Professional Education Exam, and the specific Subject Area Examination that corresponds to their program.

- General Knowledge Exam consists of four subtests: Essay, English Language Skills, Reading, and Math.
- **Professional Education exam** covers concepts such as instructional design and planning, instructional delivery, and continuous professional improvement.
- The **Subject Area Examinations** assess discipline-specific competencies and skills.

Florida A&M University (FAMU) Educator Preparation Provider (EPP) collects two types of data regarding the Florida Teacher Certificate Examinations (FTCE): first time pass rates and best attempt pass rate on specific competencies and skills for each exam. EPP compares its institutional scores with the statewide scores to better understand our programs and candidates in licensure examination. EPP uses Result Analyzer to provide the remediation plans for those who fail to pass the tests. FTCE and FELE data are also used to make changes in teaching practices and/or curricula as needed.

The first time pass rates in 2021-2022 for most of FAMU EPP initial programs are below the State fist time pass rates. EPP has concerns regarding the deficiencies. We are examining our curricula and course assignments based on the Result Analyzer and feedback from candidates.
