There were three testing cycles in 2020-2021. Students performed an average of a 55% percent on the passing rate on the CPCE. The median score changes each testing session and is compared to the national mean and reduced by one standard deviation. It is relevant to mention that the number of students also change significantly between those testing cycles. In creating the goal for this assessment, considerations for second time testers were not factored into the analysis of the data. Second time testers had an
