To prepare our prospective teachers to meet the educational demands of 21st-century students effectively, we apply a broad approach to our teacher preparation program. In these comprehensive efforts, we equip our future teachers with the knowledge, skills, and dispositions necessary to be future leaders in the field. As a college, we continue in our quest to provide a superior preparation program for our teacher candidates.

1. During the current assessment cycle, the department was tasked with addressing three major standards, relating to 1) pedagogical, 2) multicultural, and 3) technological preparation. To that end, we as a program were minimally met our goals.

2. As a strategic approach to achievement of our targeted assessment goals, each professor focused on constructing key assignments specifically designed to address the teaching standards outlined in FEAPS, InTASC, and similar delineations of highly effective teaching standards.
